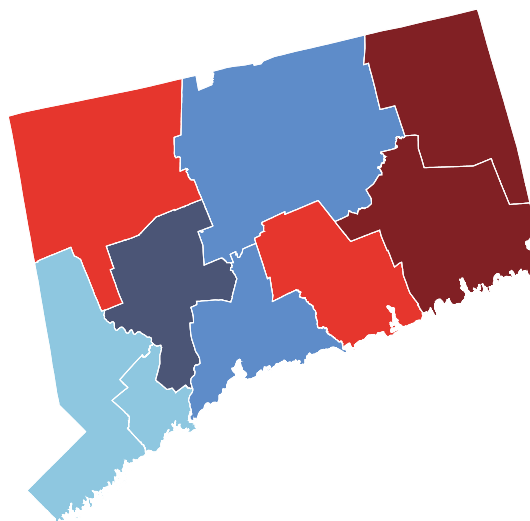
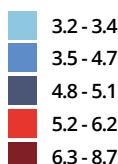

In 2023, 1,661 VA home loan guarantees were made in Connecticut to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 3.6 percent of Connecticut's home mortgage originations in 2023.
