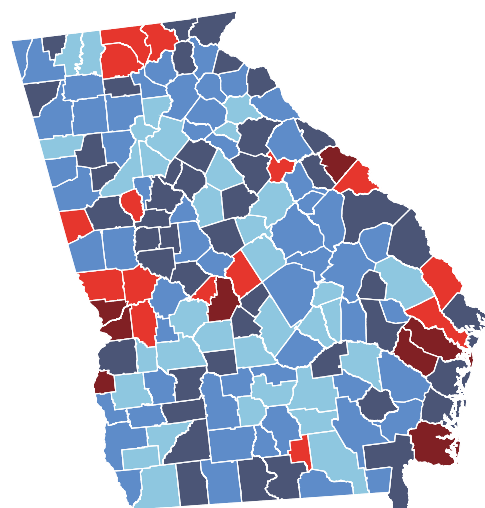
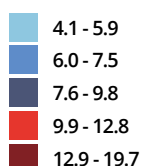

In 2023, 20,905 VA home loan guarantees were made in Georgia to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 12.3 percent of Georgia's home mortgage originations in 2023.
