



Approximately 20,270 Hawaii veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 36.1 percent of Hawaii veterans pay too much for their housing.

In 2023, 2,144 VA home loan guarantees were made in Hawaii to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 21.2 percent of Hawaii's home mortgage originations in 2023.
