


VETERAN OCCUPIED HOMES

219,394



Approximately 219,394, or 8.2 percent, of Indiana's homes are occupied by veterans.

HOME VALUE

\$169,000



The median value of Indiana veterans' homes is \$169,000. The state's overall median home value is \$180,000.

HOUSING PROBLEMS

47,050



Approximately 47,050 Indiana veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 20.5 percent of Indiana veterans pay too much for their housing.

VA MORTGAGE LOANS

6,937



In 2023, 6,937 VA home loan guarantees were made in Indiana to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 6.4 percent of Indiana's home mortgage originations in 2023.
