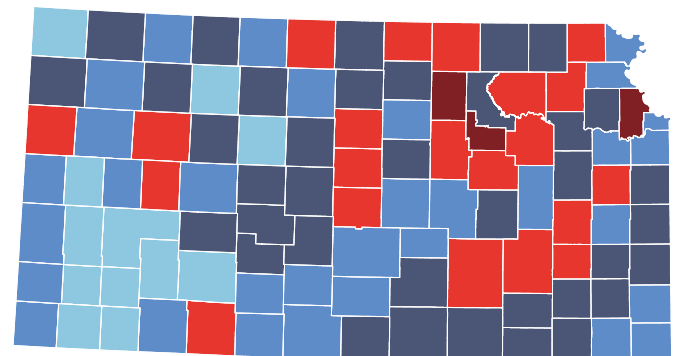
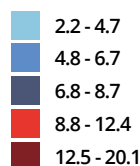

VETERAN OCCUPIED HOMES

101,652

HOME VALUE

\$175,000



The median value of Kansas veterans' homes is \$175,000. The state's overall median home value is \$180,000.

HOUSING PROBLEMS

22,405



Approximately 22,405 Kansas veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 21.2 percent of Kansas veterans pay too much for their housing.

VA MORTGAGE LOANS

3,769



In 2023, 3,769 VA home loan guarantees were made in Kansas to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 9.7 percent of Kansas's home mortgage originations in 2023.
