

HOUSING PROBLEMS 20,275



Approximately 20,275 New Mexico veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 22.0 percent of New Mexico veterans pay too much for their housing.

VA MORTGAGE LOANS 3,527



In 2023, 3,527 VA home loan guarantees were made in New Mexico to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 13.1 percent of New Mexico's home mortgage originations in 2023.

HOME-LESSNESS 298
