

Approximately 90,696 Washington veterans live in homes with one or more major problems of quality, crowding, or cost. Housing affordability is the greatest housing problem among veterans. Roughly 28.9 percent of Washington veterans pay too much for their housing.

VA MORTGAGE LOANS 9,730



In 2023, 9,730 VA home loan guarantees were made in Washington to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 10.1 percent of Washington's home mortgage originations in 2023.
